FORUM WITH TRADITIONS

The SOSEXPO Forum has gained a stable position in the calendar of events dedicated to waste management. It is one of the biggest events in Poland devoted to waste management. The topic of the conference has met very lively interest in the waste management milieu. The agenda of the Forum was prepared in tight cooperation with sector-related associations, central and local government representatives, industry chambers and associations which address waste management related issues.

PARTICIPANTS

Warsaw will host yet again the event which will gather representatives of central and local government, the waste management experts and representatives of the relevant industries as well as research institutions involved in this sector of the economy in order to discuss the most relevant issues and look for the best solutions. Similarly to last year's event, this time we expect over four hundred guests from Poland and abroad.

The SOSEXPO Forum is an annual event organized since 2012. The conference is an opportunity for the representatives of local administration, government, public institutions and companies with experts dealing with waste management.

SOSEXPO 2016 hosted over 400 participants.

MAIN CONFERENCE TOPICS

The topic of this year's conference will be focused on the circular economy. At the same time the conference will cover the assumptions included in the Strategy for Responsible Development prepared by the Ministry of Development. In this edition we want to emphasise new business models in a particular way. Innovative solutions allow recycling of the raw materials from wastes and recovery of the energy from wastes. At the same time they limit the amount of produced wastes which can result in liquidation of the troublesome landfills – a topic which will also be discussed during the Forum.

The discussion will be organised in three following topic blocks.

- The European Commission's circular economy package – presentation of an EU and Poland progress report:
- Plan of action for a circular economy – the role of local governments and entrepreneurs
- The importance of innovation in implementing a circular economy
- How should waste be included in sustainable resource management?
- Factors supporting the creation of a circular economy
- New quality of infrastructure
